



CONCRETE SCREW ANCHOR

BENEFITS

- Pilot hole required; thread is created by the anchor during the installation process.
- No special drill bit required; install using standard-sized ANSI tolerance drill bits.
- Code listed under IBC/IRC in accordance with ICC-ES AC193 and ACI 355.2 for cracked and uncracked concrete.
- · Qualified for static, wind and seismic loading conditions
- Use for heavy duty loads.
- Anchor drill bit / length stamped on head of each anchor.
- Removable, leaving concrete surface flat. Ideal for temporary anchoring (e.g. formwork, bracing) or applications where fixtures may need to be moved.
- · Suitable when reduced edge distances or spacing is required.
- · Zinc plated coating.
- Triple thread makes installation more stable; patented thread design.
